Hello LCR members & friends,

Your council held our January meeting via Zoom this past snowy Sunday, and I would like to share a couple of highlights with you.



Financially, LCR continues to be in a very strong position, and I give thanks to God for that. Income exceeds budgeted levels by \$28,400, and expenses are below budgeted levels by \$49,000. On the income side, this is driven by both offerings and facility rental income being higher than planned. Thanks to God for these blessings, and thanks to each of you for your continued faithful financial support of LCR and our ministries! Pertaining to expenses, some of this is timing related and expected to balance out over the course of the year, yet this is certainly something to be thankful for.

We are also blessed to be able to support others, and your council just approved a \$6,000 Endowment fund request for Guatemala. These funds will support Santisima Trinidad/ILAG (LCR's partner congregation in Guatemala City) with some needed sanctuary renovations. Specifically, these will support improvements for new benches and chairs, traditional liturgical furniture, and sanctuary flooring work. This is a wonderful example of how we live out our mission to deepen people's relationships with Jesus Christ and each other.

Thank you for your continued dedication to the ministries of the Lutheran Church of the Resurrection.

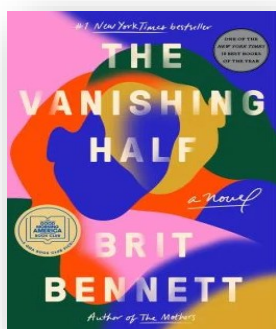
