- 1. The focus of worship is and always should be a celebration of God. God has blessed all of us in so many ways. Matthew ends his Gospel with Jesus' words, "LO, I AM WITH YOU ALWAYS, TO THE CLOSE OF THE AGE." That's how much God loves you and me and every human being in the world. That God is worthy of our worship. Worship, therefore, is first and foremost a "thank you" to God for all that God has done and been for us.
- 2. Because worship is a celebration of God, it deserves our best. It deserves excellence. Excellence in preaching. Excellence in music. Excellence in liturgy. Excellence in hospitality. Excellence in the sharing of Holy Baptism and Holy Communion. Excellence in ushering. Excellence in sound and lighting. The old phrase "good enough for church work" couldn't be further from the truth. Anything less than our best doesn't glorify God the way God deserves to be glorified.

- 3. Worship deepens our relationship with God. But it also deepens our relationships with each other. There is nothing that can build community more than to sing "Amazing Grace" together. To hear the Word of God read and preached. To witness a baptism and share in Holy Communion. To participate in the prayers of the Church. To just be together with God in the midst of all of us. The point of worship is to celebrate God. But the biggest beneficiaries of worship are you and me. The people who are blessed to be there every Sunday.
- 4. In worship, one style doesn't fit all people. Some of us love the traditional ways people have worshipped God down through the centuries. And some of us are moved by new forms of worship with new instruments and new ideas. At LCR, even during the pandemic (and maybe particularly DURING the pandemic) different options for worship have and will continue to be offered. I believe the broader our options are for worship the more we can celebrate God and the more we can involve many others in that experience.

I invite all of you to both recommit yourselves to coming TO worship and to invite others to join you FOR worship. The more that happens, the more God will be glorified and the more blessed your lives will be.
