Worship Update

The Church Council met in a special session Tuesday evening to revisit the COVID protocols in light of current trends. In the ongoing attempt to provide the congregation worship options and ways to remain connected during this pandemic, the Council voted unanimously to adopt the following protocols which went into effect February 2:



Sunday Worship Schedule:

8:30 am Traditional Sanctuary Worship

9:45 am Contemporary Parking Lot Worship

11:00 am Contemporary Sanctuary Worship

No need to make reservations to attend worship.

The tape in the Sanctuary has been removed except for the pews on the far left of the Sanctuary. That area is reserved for people choosing to social distance.

Holy Communion will again be distributed using both bread and wine.

The church buildings are now open to inside gatherings and classes.

Masks are required for all inside activities.

As has been the case during the past 2 years, the Council will continue to monitor the pandemic numbers in order to both care for the most vulnerable among us and give options for worship and group activities.

HUNGER WALK RUN

MARCH 6, 2022

LCR will again participate in this year's 38th annual Atlanta Community Food Bank Hunger Walk/Run. This event raises money to help neighbors in need of food to sustain life. More than 1 in 5 Georgia children now live in a home where hunger is a regular worry. Many proud seniors and hardworking parents are seeking food assistance for the first time in their lives.

Last year LCR had over 40 people walk, and we raised over \$12,900! We need your support this year again. Please remember that in addition to supporting the Atlanta Community Food Bank, 36% of the funds raised go to Inspiritus (formerly Lutheran Services of Georgia), and 24% comes back to LCR for our food ministries.



Like last year, LCR will be offering an in-person "LCR Hunger Walk" event at the church. The event will start at 1:00 pm in the church parking lot and walk a short loop on Robin Rd and Sherwood Rd. It was a great program in 2021 with fantastic entertainment in the parking lot and along the route, and we hope to do that again.

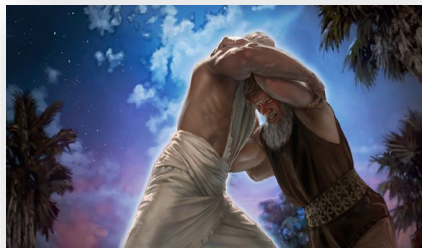
