## HUNGERWALKRUN

**MARCH 6, 2022**

Come join us at our LCR Hunger Walk/Run this year. More than 1 in 5 Georgia children now live in a home where hunger is a regular worry. Many seniors and parents are seeking food assistance for the first time in their lives. We need your support this year again. We already have 4 people signed up to walk toward our goal of 35 walkers, and we have raised about \$1,500 towards our goal of \$8,000. Remember that in addition to supporting the Atlanta Community Food Bank, 36% of the funds raised go to Inspiritus, and 24% comes back to LCR.

Like last year, LCR will be offering an in-person "LCR Hunger Walk" event at the church. The event will start at 1:00 pm in the church parking lot, and we walk a short loop on Robin Rd and Sherwood Rd. Please follow the link below to join the LCR-Marietta team. 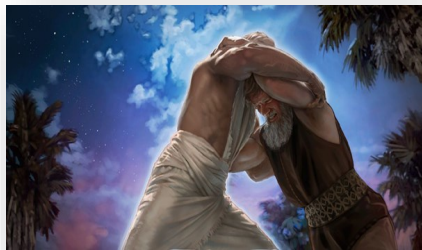
