

The Vertical & Horizontal Beam

This Lenten season we have been focusing on the cross of Jesus. It is the symbol of the Christian faith because it represents not death but love. The love that God has for every person and part of creation.

Every cross has 2 beams. The vertical beam symbolizes God's



relationship with us. It is a relationship based on God's undying love for all of creation. There is no limit to that love. God will do everything in God's power to have that relationship with us - even dying on that cross.

The horizontal beam of the cross symbolizes our relationship with each other. Those relationships too are based on love. Just as God has so loved us, now we are empowered to go and so love each other. The best way to respond to God's love is to

go and become what Luther called "little Christs to each other".

The Christian faith is a "BECAUSE...THEREFORE..." faith. Because God has so loved us, we can now go and share that love with each other. And when we do, we honor God and the love God has given us by living it out in our relationships with each other. Such is the power of living our lives beneath the cross of Jesus.
