ILAG School Supplies, Guatemala

Thanks very much to all those who donated to the La Israel School Supplies ministry of LCR. In an article in the Weekly on January 16 we talked about this ongoing ministry of LCR that provides school supplies for the elementary school in La Israel, Guatemala, and general support of ILAG's Educational Initiatives throughout the country of Guatemala.

Together we raised \$3,200. Wow! Of those funds \$600 was used to purchase the supplies for the entire year for all the students in this remote village school in La Israel in northern Guatemala. ILAG purchases and delivers the supplies to the village. The remaining funds will support their broader Educational Ministry programs. Those broader programs include scholarships for young men and women to go for additional education beyond that provided in the villages, for children at the Lutheran School in Guatemala City, and for adults for Leadership Development training to teach and preach in their villages.




Maundy Thursday, April 14
